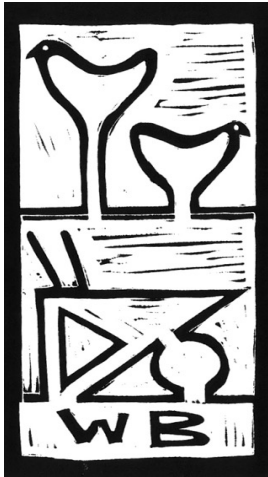


Announcing the eighth biannual
Wheelbarrow Books Poetry Prize

\$1,000 Award and Publication



The RCAH Center for Poetry at Michigan State University, in cooperation with the MSU Press is pleased to announce the sixth biannual Wheelbarrow Books Poetry Prize, open to poets who have not yet published a first book. The winner will receive \$1,000 and publication in 2021 under the Wheelbarrow Books imprint.

Eligibility

- Manuscripts are eligible for the Wheelbarrow Books Poetry Prize if the author has not yet published a collection of original poetry. Translations are not eligible.
- Current faculty, staff, and students of Michigan State University are not eligible to submit their work.
- Multiple submissions are welcome and simultaneous submissions are acceptable (please inform us if the manuscript is accepted elsewhere).
- The Center for Poetry in the Residential College in the Arts and Humanities at MSU reserves the right to consider all entrants for publication; a list of winners and finalists will be posted on the Center for Poetry website (poetry.rcah.msu.edu) in June 2020 after the winning author is notified.
- Publication is contingent upon the poet's agreeing to the terms of the publishing agreement.

Rules and Submission Guidelines

- Manuscripts must be in English and a minimum 64 pages.
- Manuscripts must be typed in a 12-point font.
- Manuscripts must be accompanied by two title pages: one with the title of the collection, the author's name, address, email address, and telephone number; and one with only the title. Manuscripts will not be returned.
- Submitted poems may have appeared previously in journals, anthologies, or chapbooks, but the collection as a whole must be previously unpublished.
- Manuscripts must be postmarked between December 15, 2019, and February 29, 2020. Early submissions are encouraged. For proof of receipt, send the manuscript using a delivery confirmation service.
- Include the nonrefundable reading fee of \$25 as a check or money order payable to Michigan State University. Please include "Wheelbarrow Books Poetry Prize" on the memo line.
